| 1. CAP- COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE FOOD PROGRAM - (951) 485-7792 | \$30,600 |
| Provides emergency and supplemental food and referrals to families and individuals in need. Also provides clothing and utility payment assistance when available. | |
| 2. GOD'S HELPING HAND FOOD PROGRAM - (951) 653-2529 | \$9,000 |
| Provides emergency and supplemental food, clothing, and referrals to families and individuals in need. | |
| 3. P.W. ENHANCEMENT CENTER EMERGENCY SERVICES – (951) 242-7001 | \$15,000 |
| Provides emergency outreach services to persons and families in need, including motel vouchers and shelter placement assistance for homeless persons, rental assistance, food distribution, job search assistance and referrals. | |
| 4. LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICES TRANSITIONAL LIVING PROGRAM - (951) 656-6020 | \$15,000 |
| A transitional program for homeless women and children that provides long term housing, case management, life skills training, counseling, and other services to promote self sufficiency and independent living. | |
| 5. PATH OF LIFE MINISTRIES - KING HALL SHELTER - (951) 697-4195 | \$15,000 |
| A transitional program for homeless individuals and families that provides long term housing, case management, life skills training, counseling, and other services to promote self sufficiency and independent living. | |
| 6. OPERATION SAFEHOUSE SHELTER - (951) 351-4418 | \$8,000 |
| Provides shelter, food, clothing, counseling, education and support services for runaway/throwaway children aged 11-17 in a safe and supervised environment. Shelter is located in Riverside. | |
| 7. OLIVE CREST TREATMENT CENTER – (951) 686-8500 | \$10,000 |
| Provides residential treatment, counseling, education and shelter for emotionally disturbed and/or abused children in a home-like setting. | |
| 8. CASA FOR RIVERSIDE COUNTY - (760) 346-2497 | \$10,000 |
| The CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates Program) provides court appointed volunteers to monitor and advocate on behalf of children in the legal and foster care systems. | |
| 9. CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION PROGRAM - (951) 686-7273 | \$7,500 |
| The Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center provides abuse prevention and education programs to children and adults through the Moreno Valley schools. | |
| 10. ASSISTANCE LEAGUE OF RIVERSIDE - (951) 682-3445 | \$10,000 |
| The Operation School Bell program provides new "back to school" clothing, shoes, backpacks, hygiene kits and books to school aged children in need. | |
| 11. MORENO VALLEY COMMUNITY EDUCATORS – (951) 653-8631 | \$6,400 |
| An afterschool tutoring, educational enrichment, computer literacy, and mentoring program for at risk youth. | |
| 12. FRIENDS OF THE SENIOR CENTER – SENIOR VAN PROGRAM - (951) 358-9202 | \$30,000 |
| The "MoVan" is a specially equipped 17-passenger van designed to transport the elderly and adult handicapped to medical and other appointments within a 30 mile radius, at low or no cost. | |
| 13. ALTERNATIVES TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE (ADV) – (951) 320-1370 | \$10,000 |
| ADV provides comprehensive domestic violence support services including shelter, 24-hour crisis line, counseling, and referrals to battered women and their children. | |

14. RENU HOPE FOUNDATION – (951) 845-3816	\$7,500
A local low cost preschool program for infants & toddlers. Grant will be used for state mandated improvements to the playground facility.	
15. FORECLOSURE PREVENTION SERVICES – FAIR HOUSING COUNCIL (951) 653-8314	\$15,000
The Fair Housing Council of Riverside County provides foreclosure prevention assistance to homeowners through comprehensive case management, counseling & education, and lender mediation. Services are provided free of charge.	
16. YOUTH CAREER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department - (951) 413-3450	\$30,000
The City's Economic Development Department, in conjunction with Riverside Community College and the Moreno Valley Unified School District, will provide job training in the manufacturing and light logistics fields for at-risk young adults aged 18-24.	
17. SMALL BUSINESS COUNSELING SERVICE - (951) 781-2345	\$40,000
The Inland Empire Small Business Development Center (SBDC) provides technical assistance, training, and seminars for Moreno Valley small businesses on topics such as financial planning, marketing, taxes, creating a business plan and business expansion.	
18. COMMUNITY FORECLOSURE PREVENTION WORKSHOPS (City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department) – (951) 413-3450	\$12,603
A series of free foreclosure prevention workshops to provide distressed homeowners with information and resources to assist them in retaining their homes.	
19. FAIR HOUSING (DISCRIMINATION) SERVICES AND LANDLORD-TENANT MEDIATION SERVICES - (951) 653-8314	\$45,000
The Fair Housing Council of Riverside County provides comprehensive education, enforcement and investigation of fair housing discrimination complaints. The Mediation Program provides education and information on tenant and landlord rights and responsibilities, and provides dispute resolution and mediation of rental housing conflicts	
20. PROBLEM ORIENTED POLICING PROGRAM (POP TEAM) – (951) 486-6922 OR 486-6924	\$35,000
The Moreno Valley Police Department's POP Team provides crime prevention and reduction services within the CDBG Target Neighborhoods through the community policing approach of community involvement, problem solving and special projects.	
21. NEIGHBORHOOD CODE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM/FORECLOSURE STRIKE TEAM (City of Moreno Valley, Community Development Department) – (951) 413-3340	\$366,407
Funding for Code Compliance staff to provide proactive enforcement of housing and property maintenance codes and to eliminate substandard housing conditions within the CDBG Target Areas. Staff will be assigned to specifically identify and address the proliferation of unmaintained vacant and foreclosed homes.	
22. MV RETAIL INCENTIVE PROGRAM (City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department – (951) 413-3450	\$525,000
The Retail Business Incentive Program is intended to attract reputable retailers to locate in large, vacant retail space in the TownGate commercial centers through loans, grants or interest subsidies in exchange for the creation of jobs for low and moderate income persons.	
23. COMMUNITY EMPLOYMENT RESOURCE CENTER (City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department) – (951) 413-3450	\$308,498
The Center provides computers, internet access, resume preparation, employment/job search opportunities, and unemployment benefit application services free of charge to job seekers and the unemployed.	
24. PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION (City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department) – (951) 413-3450	\$312,923
Administration of the CDBG Program, project development, environmental reviews, reporting, special studies, program contracts and monitoring.

1. HOME IMPROVEMENT LOAN PROGRAM	\$160,000
City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department - (951) 413-3450 Low interest (3%) deferred loans for income qualified homeowners to rehabilitate single family homes.	
2. MOBILE HOME GRANT PROGRAM	\$80,000
City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department - (951) 413-3450 Program provides a one-time grant of up to \$10,000 to income qualified owner-occupants of mobile homes to repair and eliminate substandard conditions. Participants must rent space within a Moreno Valley mobile home park.	
3. MULTI FAMILY AFFORDABLE HOUSING	\$297,229
City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department - (951) 413-3450 Rehabilitation or construction of affordable multi family housing units for very low income renters.	
4. CHDO (COMMUNITY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION) HOUSING	\$99,966
City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department - (951) 413-3450 Rehabilitation or construction of a multi family affordable housing project for very low income residents. Project to be developed by a Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO).	
5. HOME PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION	\$66,644
City of Moreno Valley, Economic Development Department - (951) 413-3450 Administration of the HOME Program, project development, environmental reviews, reporting, special studies, program contracts and monitoring.
